SUMMARY

The subject is organized through an offer of different courses on current historiographical debates and controversies on contemporary history themes. According with the inter-university nature of the master's degree, the courses proposed by each of the universities participating in the master's degree will form part of the offer available to students. The courses will be carried out through one of the virtual platforms of the participating universities. The activity of this subject, therefore, will be virtual and the students will follow the chosen courses.
