## SUMMARY

The subject *Introduction to Social Protection Law* is part of the integrating core subjects of the module Legal and Organizational Instruments in Social work. It is worth 6 ECTS credits and compulsory.

The subject intends to provide students with basic knowledge on the legal conditions within the traditional term “social law” and the achievement of objectives since the aims of social intervention are, among others, the resolution of problems that arise from human relations, as well as the strengthening of welfare and social cohesion.

Within what is usually denominated “social law” is the notion of “social protection law” which, according to many sources (political, legal and doctrinal), must not only be understood as the set of legal regulations that make up the social security system, but also, in a more comprehensive way, as the set of legal mechanisms aimed at providing real equality and improvement of social solidarity.



Yet, and given that in order to fulfil these objectives the public powers implement many and diverse policies to different fields, the subject leaves some of them out (housing, education or transport) and focuses on those related to social work (provision of services). Work and conditions that respect real equality are one of the first and main tools in the fight against exclusion and the encouragement of social cohesion.

The present subject also intends to offer useful legal information, regardless of the specialization itinerary chosen by the students. Issues like health protection (both preventive and palliative); immigration laws and free movement of workers and services, both within and outside the EU; mechanisms to reconcile work and family life; protection against discrimination of any kind (sex, race, sexual orientation, age, disability).
