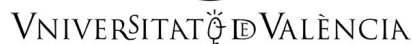
**SUMMARY**

*Human Rights: Social Rights* is a basic formation subject of the Degree in Social Work.

The subject is aimed at introducing students to the legal dimension of social work and three basic aspects: human rights (especially social rights); legal systems as institutions that guarantee these rights, that is, the different modalities of the Rule of Law and the scope of human rights in the ethical dimension of the performance of social work.
