The content of this subject is located within the optional modules. From the particular perspective of Social Psychology, it is intended to deepen the knowledge of the social vulnerability produced in people who experience processes of rupture and personal alienation in situations of dependency and maladjustment. Situations of adaptation / maladjustment are analyzed as a process in which people live their relationships of socialization and ruptures through the main socializing institutions and evolutionary processes, so we will show particular attention to the concept of vital development and the ways in which the images and representations of dependency and social maladjustment are produced.

FIRST CALL

2- Evaluation of projects (program / project aimed at people and situations of social maladjustment) or academic works (theoretical review or short essay) that promote the development of abilities to search and select information, organization or critical thinking.

For the evaluation, the ability to search and select information, coherence, organization and sequencing of objectives, activities and results, critical thinking, creativity and applicability will be taken into account.

Weighting between 0.0 and 40.0

The final grade obtained by the students, in the First Call, will be the sum of the two scores (Written test + projects or academic work).
