TEACHING METHODOLOGY

La metodología de enseñanza-aprendizaje habitual será la exposición del profesor y el debate entre los miembros de la clase, que se combinará con el seminario de trabajo sobre los textos indicados, por lo cual es imprescindible que exista un estudio previo y autónomo por parte del alumnado y una discusión y participación en las sesiones, que son obligatorias.

EVALUATION

La evaluación constará de 2 partes diferenciadas:

Examen escrito individual: La prueba por escrito, que valora el dominio conceptual y técnico de la materia, y que se realizará en las fechas que se determinen oficialmente. Esta prueba tendrá un valor del 70% de la nota final.

Evaluación continua o ejercicios durante el curso: Esta prueba valorará las habilidades de búsqueda bibliográfica e información, así como la capacidad de elaboración crítica y fundamentada de lo aprendido y tendrá un valor del 30% de la nota final.

Para aprobar el conjunto de la asignatura es necesario alcanzar al menos un 50%.

ADDENDUM COVID-19

This addendum will only be activated if the health situation requires so and with the prior agreement of the Governing Council

1.- Contents

The essential contents are maintained, in any case, since they are necessary to master the competences linked to this subject, although the length and emphasis can be adapted to the circumstances of each moment.

2.- Volume of work and temporary planning of teaching

The volume of work required to pass this subject is maintained, trying to adapt the procedures and activities to that end.

3.- Teaching methodology

In this subject teaching combines face-to-face with non-attendance, synchronous or asynchronous. The level of attendance will be adapted to the social and health conditions of each moment and to the specific conditions of the subject. It will be a hybrid model, so that the classes will be taught with the possible presence and the rest will be carried out in person. In any case, this hybrid model must necessarily be flexible in order to adapt to the circumstances.

In non-face-to-face teaching, synchronous modalities will be prioritized, which favor direct interaction with students

- Uploading materials to the virtual classroom
- Proposal of activities by virtual classroom
- BBC synchronous and asynchronous videoconferencing
- Discussions in the forum
- Cases and exercises done in class and at home.
- Tutorials via videoconference
- Forums in Virtual Classroom

4.- Evaluation

Continuous assessment activities will be promoted, which, on the other hand, can be combined with the requirement to pass specific activities, including a final global assessment. The details of the process will be specified in the classroom guide, taking into account the circumstances.
