## SUMMARY

En esta asignatura se pretende dotar al estudiante de las herramientas conceptuales necesarias para enfrentarse a la interpretación y aplicación de este sector del ordenamiento, prestándose atención a la doctrina jurisprudencial y administrativa existente. Se aborda el estudio de los institutos esenciales del ordenamiento tributario, es decir, de la comúnmente denominada Parte general del Derecho financiero y tributario, dentro del grado en Ciencias políticas y de la Administración pública, desde el análisis de los principios constitucionales hasta el estudio de los procedimientos tributarios, pasando por las fuentes normativas, la interpretación las categorías tributarias y los elementos esenciales del tributo. También se aborda lo más esencial del sistema tributario español, examinándose la imposición sobre la renta, la imposición sobre el consumo, centrada ésta en el impuesto sobre el valor añadido y efectuándose una incursión en temas sometidos a debate en la actualidad como lo es la tributación medio-ambiental. Integrándose asimismo la perspectiva internacional de la tributación.
