PROTOCOL• 5 periods of Labor defense are established (Law Faculty website)• The oral defense will take place in a public space of the Faculty of Law, or of the department or center to which the tutor of the Work is assigned or, when necessary, by electronic means that allow simultaneous communication between the tutor and student (videoconference or similar) and that they guarantee, at the discretion of the tutor, the correct evaluation of the work. • The / the student agrees with the / the tutor / the date of oral defense of the Work within the periods foreseen. • The tutor confirms the date by means of an email sent to the student. o Complete TFG report. o Copy of the confirmation email from the tutor. • Upon completion of the request, the student receives a document supporting the deposit request. From that moment on, be aware of notifications from ENTREU, as additional information may be required. • The Secretary of the Faculty of Law admits the deposit after verifying the fulfillment of the



following requirements: o Pass all the 3rd year subjects. (4th. In the case of double degrees) and enrollment of the rest of the degree subjects. • The favorable resolution of the deposit process from the Secretariat entails the automatic performance of the following processes in the information systems of the University of Valencia: o Storage of the memory in the Virtual Classroom sub-community for the TFG (one for each degree) o Notification to the student of the acceptance of the reading date. o Notification to the tutor of the authorization of the defense

• The act of defense will be recorded in sound recording at the request of the student. • Once the defense act has been held, the tutor evaluates the TFG and completes the reading report (Annex III attached to the TFG Instructions) and the evaluation report. You may use Annex IV attached to the TFG Instructions for this purpose. • The tutor files with the Secretary of the Department to which the defense report and the evaluation report are attached. • In the event that the work opts for honorary registration, the grant proposal must be sent to the Secretariat of the Faculty of Law (tfgdret@uv.es) together with the reasoned report signed by the tutor. to work. • The Secretary of the Department or, in any case, the person designated by the Department; fill in and sign the evaluation documents that must be sent to the Secretariat of the Faculty of Law within 5 days following the end of each of the submission periods indicated at the beginning of this protocol.(1) The TFG Committee shall annually approve the reading periods according to the academic calendar of each course.
