TEACHING METHODOLOGY

Se combinarán las clases teóricas y prácticas con el trabajo en grupo.

(a) Clases teóricas: Se combinará la clase magistral, para introducir nuevos conceptos, con la reflexión y discusión a partir de la presentación de casos prácticos.

(b) Clases prácticas: se realizarán y corregirán ejercicios de traducción y de análisis contrastivo para resolver problemas concretos de traducción general alemán-español, en forma de ejercicios individuales, en tándem y en pequeños grupos.



(c) Trabajo individual tutorizado: el alumno deberá entregar cada semana una o dos traducciones, que serán corregidas en clase o revisadas por el profesor.

EVALUATION

La evaluación consta de tres partes:

- a) Actividades evaluables a lo largo del cuatrimestre: 25%
- b) Participación activa en clase: 15%
- c) Tres/cuatro pruebas escritas parciales presenciales: 60%

Total: 100%

La calificación final se obtendrá de la suma de los apartados a), b) y c). Es condición necesaria haber alcanzado una media de 4 sobre 10 en el apartado c) para aprobar la asignatura.

La asistencia a clase no es obligatoria, pero sí lo es la entrega de las tareas prácticas. Esta se realizará a través del aula virtual en la fecha y forma que indicará el profesor. El retraso en el envío de una tarea conllevará una penalización en la nota referida a este apartado de la evaluación.

No está prevista la realización de un examen final en esta asignatura. Los alumnos que no alcancen el aprobado, mediante la suma de los apartados a), b) y c) de la evaluación, en primera convocatoria deberán presentarse al examen de segunda convocatoria, previsto para junio de 2021. Únicamente podrán realizar este examen los estudiantes que hayan entregado todas las tareas correspondientes al apartado a) de la evaluación, si bien la calificación en segunda convocatoria resultará exclusivamente de la nota obtenida en dicha prueba escrita.
