This subject intends to acquaint students with the German language in academic and professional environments. Attention will be drawn on linguistic variation and the processes of discourse construction and organisation in the specialised genres.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

En la asignatura se combinarán las clases teóricas y prácticas con el trabajo individual y grupal tutorizado por el profesor.



(a) Clases teóricas: se expondrán los contenidos a desarrollar en cada uno de los temas. Se combinará la clase magistral, sobre todo en la introducción de nuevos conceptos, con la reflexión y discusión a partir de la presentación de casos prácticos. Se instruirá al alumno en la utilización de procedimientos tanto inductivos como deductivos para la identificación de fenómenos lingüísticos y la resolución de problemas de carácter teórico sobre aspectos diversos de la lengua alemana de especialidad a partir del enfrentamiento directo con textos ejemplares de los ámbitos estudiados, así como del aprovechamiento de los materiales de referencia.

(b) Clases prácticas: se realizarán y corregirán ejercicios que el profesor facilitará a lo largo del curso. Los contenidos de los distintos ejercicios y actividades versarán sobre los contenidos teóricos expuestos en clase, y enfrentarán a los alumnos problemas concretos de la descripción del alemán contemporáneo en sus diversas manifestaciones textuales en los ámbitos académicos y profesionales. Se recurrirá a diferentes actividades de carácter participativo e interactivo: ejercicios individuales, en parejas, en pequeños grupos.

(c) Trabajo individual y grupal tutorizado: el profesor concertará tutorías a realizar individualmente y en pequeños grupos.

EVALUATION

La evaluación será continua durante todo el cuatrimestre. El examen final escrito se realizará en convocatoria oficial.

Las actividades evaluable durante el cuatrimestre consisten en lo siguiente:

- Asistencia (10%)
- Proyecto (trabajo en grupo) (20%)
- Actividades en Aula Virtual (20%)

Exámenes finales:

- Examen final escrito (30%)
- Examen oral (20%)

En segunda convocatoria no se puede recuperar ninguna actividad evaluable, salvo el examen escrito final y el examen oral.

Para poder presentarse al examen oral es necesario haber aprobado el examen escrito final con una nota mínima de 5 sobre 10.
