## TEACHING METHODOLOGY

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## EVALUATION

The evaluation will consist of 3 distinct parts:

- Informative work on a scientific issue (40 % of the final mark)
- Classroom practices (30 % of the final mark)



- Theoretical exam of the contents presented in class (30 % of the final mark)

### **Assessment criteria**

- Theory:** the learning of the different communicative strategies of science communication will be assessed.
- Practical work:** the student's ability to successfully develop the different written forms of journalistic genres related to the dissemination of science will be assessed.

The completion of the practicals is compulsory in order to pass the course. These tasks can be recovered in the second exam (provided that the practicals have been taken and passed).

### **Attention:**

Intellectual honesty is vital in academic communities, and for the fair assessment of student work. All work submitted for this course must be original authorship. Papers that make use of fraudulent collaboration or composition with the help of artificial intelligence (ChatGPT or others) will not be accepted.

In the case of plagiarism in a student's assessment work, this may be marked with a numerical grade of zero and lead to the suspension of the course, regardless of the disciplinary procedure that may be initiated and, if applicable, the appropriate sanction in accordance with current legislation.
