 - Determine the competence framework of any legal regulation and know the institutional system of the Autonomous Community of Valencia within the general constitutional framework.
 - Knowing the concept of the Constitution as a legal norm and the system of sources - Properly handling the fundamental concepts of the Theory of the Constitution, fundamentally, the concept of the Constitution and its instrumental notions.
 - Understand the normative meaning of the modern concept of the Constitution and its implications for the system of sources. Determine the position of any legal norm in the current complex system of sources. Ability to identify the sources of Law applicable to any legal problem and to be familiar with codes or legislative compilations in order to be able to search for rules using different criteria (chronological, systematic or analytical).

HYBRID TEACHING
