TEACHING METHODOLOGY

FACE-TO-FACE CLASSES: The 30 hours of teaching in the classroom will be distributed as follows:

Theoretical classes: 22.5 hours in which teachers will develop the fundamental aspects of the program.

Practical classes: 7.5 hours a year in which texts, maps and other teaching materials will be analyzed, and which will serve students as a guide in the performance of individual work.

PREPARATION OF THEORETICAL CLASSES: Students will prepare the theoretical classes according to a reading program established by teachers from the reference bibliography.

PREPARATION OF INDIVIDUAL WORK: Students will prepare an individual paper on some of the topics of the program.

TUTORIALS: Students will have individualized attention from the teachers responsible for the subject, whose objective is to make relevant consultations on any aspect related to the subject and the academic organization.



EVALUATION

General Assessment:

COMPLETION OF THE MODULE WORK:

The student will perform a work on a topic related to any of the aspects that the different subjects of the Module deal with. The work will be directed by a teacher of any of the subjects of the module that will be in charge of the evaluation of the same. The student will start the work in the Virtual Classroom, within the deadlines that appear in the table included in the General Information provided to students of the Master.

The work constitutes 70% of the final grade.

IMPLEMENTATION OF COMPLEMENTARY PRACTICES AND ACTIVITIES:

In order to complete the activities developed in the theoretical and practical classes, various complementary activities and specialized conferences will be held, which will be specified at the beginning of the course. Class attendance, conference and complementary activities with use: 30% of the total grade. The composition of the final note shall, in summary, take account of the following percentage:
