At the end of the final work of Master, the students must be trained to develop a research work. To do this, they must be able to: Choose an issue or question to investigate; preparing a research proposal, saying the issue; identify and know work the existing literature on the subject; locate the available data as well as real-world examples that may be useful in the characterization of the problem; organize and present the ideas in the introduction of the work; to analyze a question either from the theoretical



perspective, such as empirical as the experimental; conclude with results arising from the analysis, write using a academic language and present and defend publicly such work.

DESCRIPTION OF CONTENTS

1. Master Final Project (TFM)

The type of work can be: bibliographic reviews; experimental analysis; work coordinated with practices; or the derivative of stays abroad

The extension of the work is limited to a maximum of 60 pages, 1.5 spaces, source 12 and margins 2.5, unless the tutor authorizes a larger extension.

TEACHING METHODOLOGY

1. Subject selection and tutor

The list of subjects and tutors will be posted in the Virtual Classroom. In addition to those topics, the student may propose other ones of the economic policy and the public economy.

The student must contact the teacher to request the tutorial of the TFM.

Once the subject has been agreed with the teacher, the coordinator will be informed of the TFM, Antonio Sánchez (tono.sanchez@uv.es)

The deadline to communicate the choice of subject and tutor to the coordinator is the beginning of December.

If a student wishes to change the tutor, they must write a motivated letter to the Master CCA, which will resolve after hearing the opinion of the tutor.

2. Work Delivery

There are two calls to deliver the work: one in July and one in September that will be made public at the beginning of each course by the Master CCA. Apart there is the option of an advanced call (which may be of interest for students who took the Master's course last year and they were left pending the completion of the TFM).

The complete work must be delivered to the tutor before depositing it in the Secretariat of the Faculty of Economics and in Entreu. Only if the tutor gives the approval, is may proceed to deposit the final project (TFM).



The template for the approval of the tutor is posted in a virtual classroom.

The delivery and deposit of the work will be made through the "Entreu" section of the Universitat de València.

3.1. Work Deposit

- The delivery will consist of 3 copies on paper that must be submitted to the Graduate Office of the Faculty of Economics, and must also send digitally through the "entreu": a copy of the TFM in pdf, pdf statement of no plagiarism and pdf of the tutor approval for reading.

Entreu ==> students (access with username and password) ==> TFM ==> attach pdf TFM, pdf statement not plagiarism and pdf authorization tutor.

- The deadlines for depositing the TFM will be communicated by the CCA each year in advance.

3. Detail documentation to be presented by the students in the entreu

- The pdf file of the Master's Final Project.
- A pdf file with a statement of no plagiarism signed by the student (a copy of this document will be available in the virtual classroom in the TFM folder)
- A pdf file with Printed tutor authorization for deposit (the copy of this document will be available in the virtual classroom in the TFM folder). This document must be signed by the tutor and must also be indicated by the tutor if the student will make the defense of 15 minutes (it will be understood that his grade is 9 or higher) or the defense of the TFM is 5 minutes (well it will be understood that your grade is between 8.9 and 5).

EVALUATION

The dates established for the evaluation of the TFMs will be established by the CCA when the number of students to be evaluated is known and they have deposited their TFM. There will be two calls for evaluation: one in July and another in September. Apart there is the possibility of requesting an advanced call.

The tutor will propose to the court the note that he considers appropriate for the TFM. However, the qualification of the work corresponds to the TFM court constituted for that purpose.

All the works will be exposed publicly. There are two types of exhibitions. In the first place, the works whose note proposed by the tutor be less than 9 will be exposed for a time of 5 minutes. The exhibition will contain the purpose of the work, its structure, method and conclusions.

Only in those cases in which the tutor proposes a grade equal to or higher than 9, then a public defense of the TFM will be held for a time of 15 minutes. The qualification of the court will oscillate between 0 and 10 points.



Those TFMS that the tutors have derived to presentations of 5 minutes will prepare their presentation and send it to tono.sanchez@uv.es, and angeles.tortosa@uv.es the day before the defense.

The evaluations will be face-to-face and only exceptionally for duly justified reasons can the defense and evaluation be carried out through a video conference. The request for this type of presentation will be made to the CCA, which will decide its convenience in each case.

TFMs that have been submitted to 15-minute presentations will directly explain their presentation to the court, without prior sending.

Evaluation of the Final Master's Project: 80%

Presentation and defense of Master's Final Project before a court: 20%

The qualification will be communicated through Virtual Classroom once they have been made all the readings and evaluations of submitted works.

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
