SUMMARY

This course's main objective is that students put into practice the knowledge acquired through practices in health facilities where at least there will be two clinical psychologist or General Health psychologist. The practices are intended to encourage and produce learning do you "know do" "want to do", "can to do" and "know to be", that is knowing how to play the professional rol. It is not only know and apply techniques and intervention strategies, but especially to acquire an apprenticeship role, communication skills, development of empathy and all those skills that are necessary for the proper professional development of a / a psychologist / a toilet.

Despite the heterogeneity of existing practices, they can be drawn aspects common to all of them, which are the objectives of this subject, which can be summarized as:

- Know detect, assess and diagnose needs and situations requiring the intervention of a psychologist overall health.
- Know how to identify behaviors, problems, needs and make a psychological intervention in this regard.
- Know how to identify and implement the useful resources to carry out that intervention.



- Make oral and written reports.
- Implement professional attitudes and skills appropriate and effective
- Know how to manage different customer relations.
- Develop cooperative skills with other professionals.
- Make contact with the management aspects of the profession
- To act according to the ethical principles of professional practice and regulations

DESCRIPTION OF CONTENTS

1. External Practices

The program of activities agreed by the two guardians (internal and external) include:
