SUMMARY

It consists of carrying out an initial research work directed by a professor of the program on a topic of Contemporary History, which will be presented in writing and defended before a court through oral presentation. Priority will be given to topics related to the lines of research proposed in the different optional subjects of the program. The student will preferably work on topics related to the subject or elective subjects in which they have participated and with the lines of research proposed by the professors. The resulting works should not be monographs but preparatory works for a possible doctoral thesis, which may include all or some of the following elements: 1. An Introduction in which the relevance, scientific interest and purpose of the project are defended. 2. A state of the art in which the background to the subject is presented, especially its historiographical treatment, and the different approaches from which it has been addressed, including the most relevant commented bibliography. 3. A theoretical and methodological reflection on the development of the research. 4. A list of sources to be used, indicating the performance expected from them and their location. 5. A critical analysis of a sample of these sources, or, alternatively, the elaboration of a restricted aspect of the future work, using primary sources

- Richness of the bibliography used and critical quality of the state of the matter
- Depth of source criticism
- Results of the analysis essay based on the sources used
